Activity Report – April 2014 - 2015

With tremendous support of many friends and well-wishers, the HeART BEAT Foundation was registered on 23rd April 2014 as a Trust under the INDIAN TRUST ACT, 1882 FOR CHARITABLE & SOCIAL WELFARE PURPOSES UNDER INDIAN INCOME TAX ACT, 1961 .

The Goals and Objectives of the Trust were well-defined as:

- To help the specially-abled young and under privileged artists in art education/Training/appreciation, promoting their works by organizing art education/ Training/appreciation, exhibitions, shows and online events.
- To help the specially abled young and under privileged artists to popularize their works by holding Charity Art shows where the entire proceeds of sale goes to the artist.
- To promote Giclée technique in which ink and paper used for printing are chemical free, thus making the process eco-friendly.
- To establish, buy, own, lease, rent any property for setting up own art studio/art gallery to provide non-profit platform for the specially abled and underprivileged artists to bring out their works.
- To Design and publish Coffee Table Art Books as a tool to market the art works of specially abled people.
- To extend support and grants to the needy to deliver good pieces of art this would in turn fetch a good price for their effort.
- To rightfully hold, acquire works of art in its own name for which the trust would take effort to get the trademark registered to protect the originality of the works and the concept.
- To gratuitously print, publish and distribute journals, periodicals, books, leaflets, pamphlets that the Trust may think desirable for the promotion of its objects without any intention of deriving profit or gain.
- To donate in cash or kind to all causes of similar objects and charitable purposes by reason of their locality or operation or otherwise.
- To do and carry on all other works which seem incidental and ancillary for the attainment of the above objects or any of them.

The Year at a Glance with HeART BEAT Foundation:

With the backing of **Ms Lakshmi Venkatraman**, Chennai's art critic, music critic, curator and owner of Gallery Sri Parvati, the debutante show of the Trust began in this very gallery at Eldam's Road.

The identified artist was the very deserving R Udhayakumar. Udhay, aged 39, suffers from Spinal Muscular Atrophy, but just with his right thumb & index finger alone that move in his entire body, Udhay manages to capture magic in his works of art.

Thanks to the well-known artist **Ma Se [Maniam Selvan]**, we had the opportunity to have the kind hearted artist-actor **Sivakumar** as the **Chief Guest** for the Charity Show. He has been observing/backing Udhay for many years.

Thus, the first show of HeART BEAT and **Udhay's solo art exhibition** was kicked off from **21st to 30th November 2014**. **Director Vasant Sai** joined in as a **Guest of Honour**. About 70 paintings found display at the show titled 'Chitthamellam Enakku Oviamey'.

The short film on the artists' works, done free of cost by Lakshmi Narasimhan – Lakshu – of Creative Zone was indeed a shot-in-the-arm. Visitors had a vision of how the artist fought his ailment and yet been generating tirelessly, such works of art.

From the corporate side, Apollo Hospitals came in to support the event – by virtue of assisting in all the printing, mobilizing Udhayakumar from his home to the Gallery by their Ambulance. The trust recognizes the backing by Suganthy Sunderraj and Saravanan Raman.

The event had some good media coverage too – thanks to the backing from Apollo and their Media/PR team/Agency.

HeART BEAT Foundation and this collaborative team was able to garner financial support to the extent of over Rs 4 lacs through the sale and financial support from Apollo Hospitals. Indeed a momentous start to this humble trust.

- ♦ He lives challenging life and ensuring he didn't succumb to the ailment which made his whole body static.

Early Childhood and Education:

- ♦ He was born a normal child. At tender 10 month, he was diagnosed with Spinal Muscular Atrophy (SMA) – an ailment that affect the neurons of spinal cord and brain stem. It slowly arrested his whole bodily movement.
- ♦ However he completed his secondary schooling from St. John's School, Villivakkam.
- ♦ He was awarded best student for receiving high marks in board exam by the then Judge of High court, Madras.
- ♦ His parents and teachers discovered his inclination towards painting/art when he was in 2nd grade. He discontinued his studies after 10th due to ailment and since then, painting has been his only passion & goal.

Exhibitions:

- ♦ At the age of seven, he participated in an exhibition organized by Victoria Technical Institute in 1982. Since then, he has conducted several solo exhibitions at Lalit Kala Academy, Amethyst, Gallery Sri Parvati and Ambassador Pallava.
- ♦ Noted art & film celebrity Mr. Sivakumar was in all praise for his commitment and dedication towards art.
- ♦ Lakshmi Venkatraman's help and backing encouraged him to paint more.

Commitment towards art:

- ♦ Painting is his oxygen - and once he starts a portrait he makes sure he completes his canvas at one stretch. He is more passionate about painting Horses. He visualizes Horse as a symbol of Power and Energy.
- ♦ His attitude towards life is commendable and his Inspiring Journey defeating all odds continues - with art as a solace and the moral support of his parents and sister.

Youth beats odds to pursue passion

Udhayakumar was born healthy but tragedy struck him when he was a 11-month-old baby. He was diagnosed with Spinal Muscular Atrophy (SMA), an ailment that affects the neurons of spinal cord and brain stem, slowly arresting the entire body movement.

Since then, Udhay, now a 30-year-old man, has been able to move only his thumb and index finger. But he has not given up on life as he has taken to paintings. Will power has helped Udhay to overcome his physical limitations. The art of painting has further helped him fight the odds.

With the help of his mother, he has been creating some spectacular art pieces which are appreciated and well received by the art and culture community. "At the age of six, he tried to take a paper and pencil, which was next to his wheelchair. I assisted him. He attempted to scribble. Our family was very happy. Slowly, he started drawing images," Udhay's mother V Santhakumari told Deccan Herald.

Udhay was even equally adept in his studies when he completed his 10th grade from St John's School in Chennai. "He discontinued his studies after 10th standard due to the ailment. Since then, painting has been his only passion," said Santhakumari.

He received the best student award for scoring high marks in board exams by the then judge of Madras High Court. At the age of seven, he participated in an exhibition organised by Victoria Technical Institute in 1992.

He also has to his credit several solo exhibitions in the city, catching the imagination of the art and culture community. "More than 50 of Udhay's paintings were put on display at an exhibition in the city, the proceeds of which would be used for his treatment," said V S Ramana, Founding Trustee of HeART beat foundation that helped organise the exhibition.
